



Buying a new boat with confidence

For additional piece of mind we are members of the British Marine Federation and use their contract of sale. We prepare and agree a document that outlines in detail the obligations of both parties and includes the specification of the boat that you are purchasing together with any options. The sales document also states the stage payments and percentages to ensure that you are only paying for the amount of work that has been completed up until that date. We work with you every step of the way, typically our stage payments with customer meetings are:

- £1000.00 to reserve your building slot.
10% (less £1000 paid) upon signing the contract.
- Meeting to agree the design and layout
35% upon completion of the steelwork.
- Meeting to confirm details and materials and opportunity to take photos of progress.
35% upon installation of the engine, windows, front & rear doors, flooring, sprayfoam, first fix electrics and lining.
- Meeting to confirm finishing touches ie curtains, flooring, colours etc and agree any additional extras or alterations.
15% upon completion of the galley and bathroom.
- Meeting to view boat and agree pick-up date and final boat paint finish.
5% upon acceptance by the purchaser.
- Boat ready, tuition in boat handling can be arranged if needed.

All our narrowboats come complete with a CE mark as well as BSS certificate. The owners manual provides full details on the boats equipment and functions including full wiring diagrams. All boats come with a 12 month warranty
